



A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MCKILLOP NO. 220 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO SET THE MILL RATE, MILL RATE FACTORS, MINIMUM TAX AND SPECIAL LEVY FOR THE ORGANIZED HAMLET OF SPRING BAY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of McKillop No. 220, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Title

1. This Bylaw may be referred to as the *Mill Rate, Mill Rate Factors, Minimum Tax and Special Levy Bylaw for the Organized Hamlet of Spring Bay*.

Uniform Mill Rate

2. The uniform mill rate shall be 2.4 mills.

Mill Rate Factors

3. The mill rates factors to be applied to the uniform rate levied against all taxable property for municipal purposes in the property classes established by subsection 42(2) of *The Municipalities Regulations* are as set out in Table 1 attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Minimum Tax

4. The minimum taxes to be applied to all taxable property for municipal purposes in the property classes established by subsection 42(2) of *The Municipalities Regulations* are as set out in Table 2 attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Base Tax

5. The base taxes to be applied to all taxable property for municipal purposes in the property classes established by subsection 42(2) of *The Municipalities Regulations* are as set out in Table 3 attached to and forming part of this bylaw.



6. Special Levy

Pursuant to section 70 of the Municipalities Act and the Special Levy Agreement entered into by the RM of McKillop No. 220 and the Organized Hamlet of Spring Bay the special levy to be applied to all taxable property with improvements are as set out in Table 4 attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Property classification re minimum tax and base tax

7. Where a property is classified in more than one property class by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the minimum tax and base tax calculations shall be based on the higher of the applicable classes.

Coming into force

8. This Bylaw comes into force on the day on which it is passed.

Repeal of Former Bylaw

9. Bylaw No.390/2020, is hereby repealed.
